The Dubois, Wyoming, 4th of July Parade is unique with it's spectacular scenery as the backdrop to this charming western town.

DUBOIS, WY - With all the 4th of July parades going on, it's difficult to decide where to go. This year, the theme of the parade will be "A Tribute to Our Troops". The Wells Fargo Stage Coach will lead the parade followed by parade marshals Orv and Donna



Landon. The parade represents just about every group of folks who live and work in Dubois as well as the town's past and present. It is diverse and includes the dude ranching culture as well as the schools, churches, civic organizations, local groups and clubs.

The parade has a big horn sheep (a person in a bighorn sheep costume) driving the float for the Bighorn Sheep Center plus the forest service folks ride horses and pack mules. Of course "Smokey the Bear" will be there as well as the draft horse teams pulling hay

wagons. And don't forget the cowboys, cowgirls, antique cars and tractors, ATVs, motor bikes, motorcycles, skateboarders and mountain bikers! At the end, folks in the parade toss candy to the crowd and with the local fire trucks "spraying" overhead (and sometimes the crowd - if it's warm enough)!
